In April this year, Olympic speed skating multi-medalist Denny Morrison was spending down time with fellow speed skater Josie Spence – for this super couple, downtime is a 25-day, 1200-km bike ride from Mexico to Utah! They stopped for a breather before heading home to Alberta, and that's when things took a different turn: Denny suffered a stroke.

Josie knew the signs of stroke, so she insisted that he had to go to the hospital. Denny is on the road to recovery, but just six months after his stroke, he's competing again. And he's set a new personal best, and has another World Cup medal under his belt!
